## **Alterations to Bob's Mobil, 317 Delaware Avenue, Delmar**

Applicant: Tom Dickson, Alta East Inc

Plans to convert the existing service station into a convenient store.

Gas sales will remain, but no vehicle repairs/service will take place. Existing gas tanks will be removed and replaced with two new tanks. Willing to narrow existing curb cuts to improve traffic flow. New building and site plan will be designed in accordance with the new zoning law and comprehensive plan. Applicant shall create a few sketches using the new lot setback requirements. The front of the building will be mostly glass for security reasons. Has not decided whether to keep the existing gas canopy or install a new one. Wants to have four gas pumps. Gas service area will have hoses to reach both sides of the vehicle. The building interior layout will be similar to the "On the run" store in Menands.
