



Free Gunlock Program – Project ChildSafe®

Bethlehem Police have partnered with project ChildSafe®, an expansion of project HomeSafe®, as part of a nationwide initiative to raise awareness about safe and responsible firearm ownership and storage. Designed to make homes with firearms safer, Bethlehem Police will be offering, **at no charge**, gunlocks to those who want them. Project ChildSafe® is funded by a \$5 million grant from the United States Department of Justice and managed by the National Shooting Sports Foundation.



According to Chief Corsi, "Our goal is to improve gun safety and safety awareness to keep our families protected. Using a gun lock is a simple and practical way to prevent a terrible accident involving a firearm."

Those requesting gunlocks will not be asked to fill out or sign any documents.
