Volunteers will meet at Town Hall at 9:00 a.m.

How do I sign up?

Call ahead and let us know or simply show up and check in with the Town Supervisor or project leader on the day of the event.

If you are part of a group or organization that is interested in signing up, please let us know the name of the group and how many are participating.

If you already have a task that you do for the community (i.e., you have previously adopted a park or a median), please let us know so we can keep track of all the great things going on in our community.

When registering, please tell us how you would like to help so we can provide the proper assistance.

What do I bring?

A drink, your energy and a helpful attitude! We also suggest that you wear slacks and long sleeve shirts for protection from cuts, scrapes and insect bites.

If you would like to bring some of your own tools such as a broom, dust pan, rake, or shovel please feel free to do so.

What should I do when I have finished my task?

After you are done with your task, please return the safety vests and pick-up sticks to the project leader and let them know where your bags of trash are located so that he/she can make arrangements with the Highway Superintendent to pick them up.
