PORTABLE/INFLATABLE POOL (water depth between 24" and 48"): Code compliant barrier (fence) is required even if pool is seasonal or temporary.

ZONING SPECIFICATIONS: Submit 2 copies of a certified plot plan showing the proposed location of the pool and the location of any fence or barrier. All pool dimensions must be shown along with the distance to all property lines and gate locations on fences. **Every in-ground pool application must be accompanied by a grading plan showing the existing grading of the lot (direction of water flow) and proposed grading after installation. This must be accompanied by a completed pool grading plan checklist.** There will be an additional fee assessed by the Town Engineering Division for the review of all pool grading plans. Please see additional swimming pool information sheet for more information and requirements.

NOTE: With the issuance of this permit the Building Inspector, his Assistants, or Code Enforcement Officer having jurisdiction under the Codes of The State of New York and The Energy Conservation Construction Code of The State of New York has permission of the owners and or the contractors upon the showing of proper credentials and in the discharge of their duties may enter upon any building, structure or premise covered by this permit at any reasonable hour and no person shall thus interfere with the performance of their duties. All applicable inspections as required by the Building Inspector or his Assistants shall be completed according to the schedule attached at the time of issuance of the permit.

SWIMMING POOLS

Installation Guidelines & Answers to Common Questions

Installation and barriers shall comply with all requirements of the current version of the New York State Uniform Code and the Town of Bethlehem swimming pool and fence requirements found in the Zoning Law.

Decks surrounding or accessing an above ground pool must meet the barrier requirements found in the Uniform Code. A self-closing, self-latching, lockable device must be installed on all gates. Gates must swing out, away from the pool.

The pool enclosure must be complete, including fencing if required, before water is put in the pool.

A Splash Alarm is REQUIRED for all pools.

For in-ground swimming pools, a grading plan and excavation form are required to be submitted with the swimming pool permit application. The grading plan must show existing and proposed grade lines clearly indicating the direction of water flow. An Erosion and Sediment Control permit fee of \$150.00 will be assessed by the Town Engineering Division for review and approval of this grading permit.

Pools need to be located away from overhead power lines (contact utility directly, such as National Grid, for exact distance).

All electrical questions should be directed to a certified electrical inspector. The Town's Building Department does not do electrical inspections. Electrical inspectors are typically found listed under "**Inspection Bureaus**" or as indicated below. A final electrical inspection must be approved by a certified electrical inspection agency and recorded in the Town's Building Department before a final inspection of the pool from the Building Department can be made.
