



Community Reuse & Recycling Stations in the Town of Bethlehem:

The Town of Bethlehem proudly offers Reuse & Recycling donation containers at the following municipal locations for Clothing, Textiles, Stuffed Animals and Shoes; and Furniture, Household Items and Building Materials in the case of the Transfer Station Habitat container (see page 2).

1) **ELM AVENUE CDTA PARK & RIDE**: Located at the intersection of Elm Avenue and Rte 32, one block north of the Elm Avenue Town Park.

Clothing and other Textiles: The Town has partnered with the American Clothing Recycling Company to collect these materials for reuse and recycling; providing valuable revenue to the Town's Recycling Program from donated clothing/textiles.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- All types of clothing
- Fabric, and household textiles (tablecloths, sheets, blankets, pillows, upholstery, curtains, towels)
- Belts, hats, gloves
- Purses, bags, backpacks
- Footwear
- Stuffed animals



All items must be clean and dry, but it is okay if they are worn, torn, ripped, stained or damaged.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Mattresses
- Carpets/rugs
- Loose foam stuffing
- Toys and household goods**
** (unless specified on the donation bin).
- No wet or mildewy textiles. No smelly items.
- No items contaminated with oil, paint or hazardous materials.

2) **TOWN MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT, 407 KENWOOD AVE**: Located near the “Four Corners” intersection of Kenwood Ave and Delaware Ave, next to the Applebee Funeral Home.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- All types of clothing
- Fabric, and household textiles (tablecloths, sheets, blankets, pillows, upholstery, curtains, towels)
- Belts, hats, gloves
- Purses, bags, backpacks
- Footwear
- Stuffed animals

All items must be clean and dry, but it is okay if they are worn, torn, ripped, stained or damaged.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:
